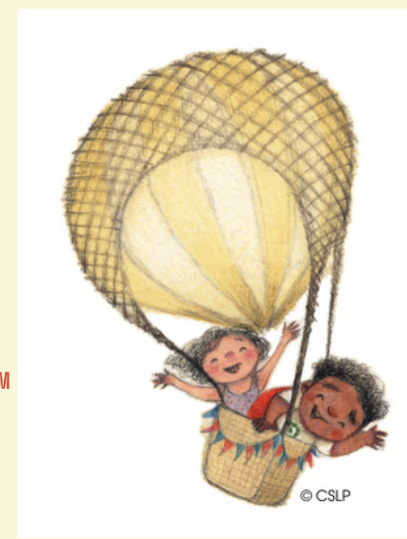

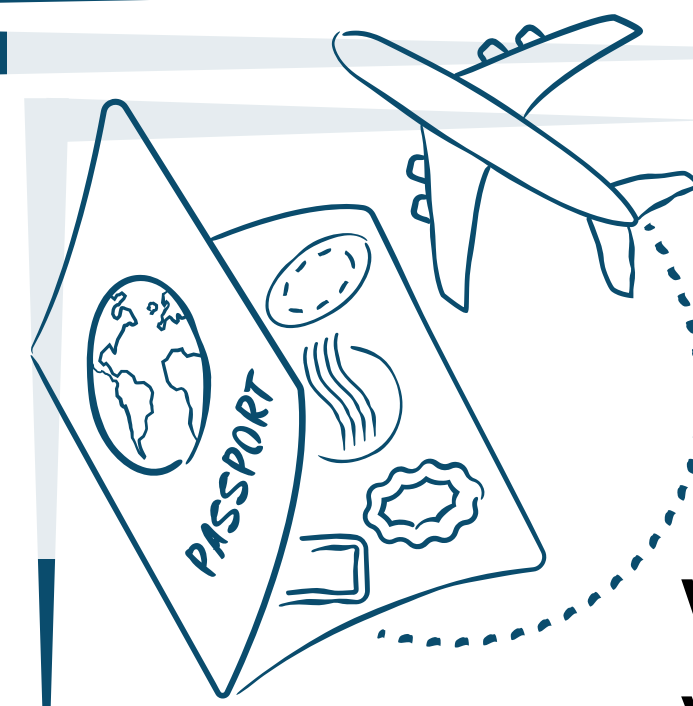
Learn About Smokey Bear
