Blank t-shirt templates are available in print at the Library or digitally on the Library website. If you are printing the template at home, please print as large as possible (on paper no larger than 11x17). The larger the starting image, the easier it will be for us to make it into the high resolution image needed to make the t-shirts.

You can submit by email (claire@pagosalibrary.org) or turn it in at the front desk.

Designs must relate to the theme of "Tails and Tales". Please include the words "Tails and Tales" somewhere in your design.

All designs must be original. You may not use artwork or images made or owned by someone else. The images on this page are for inspiration only and may not be used in your design as they are copyrighted.

The winning design will be made into t-shirts for staff to wear during summer reading, and the designer of the winning t-shirt will receive a t-shirt as well.

Please do NOT color the entire template. If you think a particular background color would be good with your design, feel free to make note of it, but please leave the background white. This will make it easier for us to submit the design for production.
